ABOUT PUSHKAR



Pushkar is a city, near Ajmer City. It is a pilgrimage site for Hindus and Sikhs. Pushkar has many temples and the most famous among Pushkar temples is the red spired Brahma Temple. It is considered a sacred city by the Hindus particularly in Shaktism, and meat and eggs consumption are forbidden in the city. It is located on the shore of Pushkar Lake, which has many ghats where pilgrims bathe.



PUSHKAR LAKE

According to Hindu scriptures, the sacred Pushkar Lake is described as 'Tirtha Raj', the king of all pilgrimage sites. No pilgrimage is considered to be complete without a dip in the holy Pushkar Lake. Semi-circular in shape and about 8-10 metres deep, Pushkar Lake is surrounded by 52 bathing ghats and over 400 temples and is truly a magnificent sight to behold.

BRAHMA TEMPLE

Nestled in the picturesque Pushkar valley beyond the Nangaparvat and Anasagar Lake, the Brahma temple holds a special place in the hearts of Indians. It is the only temple in the world dedicated to Lord Brahma. Built with marble and decorated with silver coins, this temple can be identified by its red spire and the image of a swan (considered sacred to Lord Brahma). The chaturmukhi (four faced) idol of Lord Brahma is housed in the inner sanctum. A marble statue of the sun god stands sentinel at the temple..



GURUDWARA SINGH SABHA

Gurudwara Singh Sabha, situated in the eastern part of Pushkar, was built in the beginning of the 19th century to commemorate the visits of the first and the tenth gurus-Guru Nanak Dev and Guru Govind Singhji.

DUMPING YARD

The Dumping Yard in Kishangarh, near Ajmer, Rajasthan, is a unique tourist attraction known for its vast, white marble slurry piles. Originally intended as a waste disposal site for marble processing by-products, the accumulated slurry created a surreal, snow-like landscape that attracts photographers and visitors. It's also known as "Snow Mines" and "Switzerland of Rajasthan".



CAMEL SAFARIS

There is no better way to explore the vastly enchanting desert of Rajasthan. Pushkar Camel Safari not only offers desert travels but also keeps tourists entertained with various outdoor activities. The safari has options to suit the needs of the visitors. Safari tours commence with villages across desert and end at sunset by the beautiful sand dunes.

There will be 2 categories for abstract submission namely

- 1) E-Poster
- 2) Oral Paper

E-Poster will consist of the following subheadings Introduction, Case Description, Conclusion

Oral Paper will consist of the following subheadings Title, Background, Methodology, Results, Conclusion

E-POSTER GUIDELINES

- Abstract should not be more than 250 words
- File format should be PowerPoint (.PPT/.PPTX)
- Total size of the presentation should not exceed 5MB
- 1 slide per poster
- Animations/sounds/videos should not be used Title and Presenting Author's name should be written at the top of the Poster
- A passport size photograph of the presenter should be included in the presentation
- Qualifications of the presenting author, affiliations, Names of guides/coguides and institution logos are not allowed to be printed on the poster
- Poster should be in MS power point; Times New Roman font and font size 12 pt.
- Screens provided ratio will be 16:9 and the size will be approximately 48X30 inches
- Bonafide certificate from the HOD of the department should be attached with the abstract
- The E- Poster presentation time will be 5 Minutes + 1 Minute Discussion.

ORAL PAPER GUIDELINES

- Abstract should not be more than 300 words
- Abstract should be in MS word, Times New Roman font and font size 12 pt. or Power Point (.PPT/.PPTX).
- The presentation time will be 6 Minutes + 2 Minute Discussion.
- Title and Presenting Author's name should be written at the top of the Paper
- The no. of slide for presentation may be upto 6 slides
- Qualifications of the presenting author, affiliations, Names of guides/co-guides and institution logos are not allowed to send with paper
- Bonafide certificate from the HOD of the department should be attached with the abstract.
